

To Our Residents and Families: 10.22.2020

As previously communicated and as a follow-up concerning a resident who resides at Neville Center who tested positive while at the hospital. We would like to inform you that we contacted the State epidemiologist and a re-test was sent to the State lab. **We have confirmation that this test is negative.** Out of caution this resident will remain in quarantine for the 20 days as suggested by the Cambridge Board of Health.

For clarification, our resident was sent to the hospital for a procedure. This resident had previously tested positive for COVID-19 in April and recovered. Per the Department of Public Health and CMS, nursing centers are required to return every resident back to the center from the hospital regardless of testing positive for COVID-19 or if the results of COVID-19 are pending. Neville Center abides by all guidance set forth by state and federal regulations.
