We are writing to you to keep you updated on our latest results. **The information we are providing may include additional COVID positive case increases due to the following:**

- At this time we are admitting patients from the hospital for rehabilitation.
- Some of the admissions are those in need of care for recovery from COVID-19.
- We are following the guidance from CDC and the Department of Public Health by placing all hospital admissions regardless of positive or negative in quarantine for 14 days.
- We have dedicated units and staff to care for positive and negative patients. We also follow all guidelines for the use of PPE (Personal Protective Equipment).

Be assured that we are doing everything possible to minimize the spread and transmission of COVID-19 as we continue to provide the highest level of care for all our patients. The following are preventative measures that we are using to limit the spread of the disease and ensure patient safety:

- All residents are monitored for signs and symptoms of respiratory illness
- All entrants to the building are screened for signs or symptoms of COVID-19 including taking temperatures prior to entry
- Staff members who have symptoms or who have tested positive are immediately placed on medical leave and quarantined based on CDC and state guidelines
- We always adhere to CDC and state health department requirements regarding the use of personal protective equipment (PPE) and infection control measures
- We have temporarily ceased all communal activities
- All visitation has been restricted
